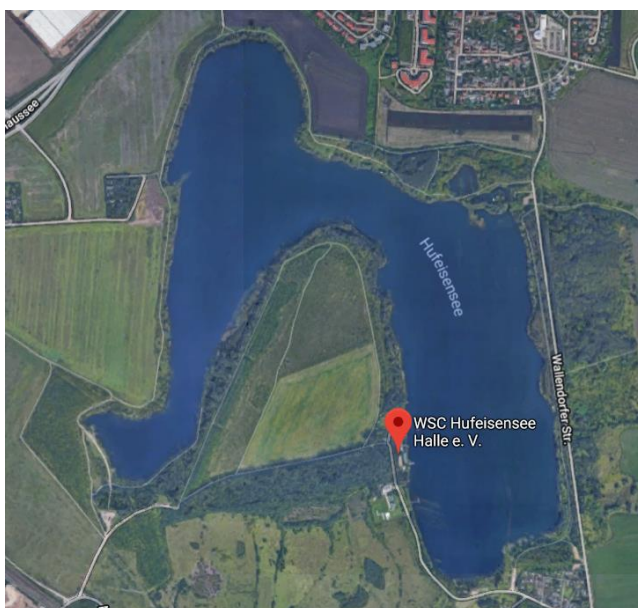
The Waterski Complex has already organized big events. Our organization and structure can meet all your needs. The site has a long Waterski history.

HALLE-LUJAH: Halle - The Charming City On The River Saale!

Together with the neighbouring metropolis of Leipzig, the city forms the Metropolitan area Leipzig-Halle, a region with more than one million inhabitants, and the metropolitan region of Central Germany with Leipzig and five other cities in Saxony-Anhalt, Saxony and Thuringia.

Halle is home of one of the oldest universities in Germany, the Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg, as well as the castle Giebichenstein Kunsthochschule. In addition, the city is the seat of the National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina and the Federal Cultural Foundation, which have the tasks of the international representation of national science and German culture for the Federal Republic of Germany. There is a wide range of cultural and museum facilities in the city, such as the Moritzburg Foundation or the National Museum of Prehistory.

Furthermore, the Weinberg Campus is an important technology and founding centre in the new regions.

Halle is the birthplace of the composer George Frideric Handel of a world-famous German-British composer of the Baroque. His main work includes 42 operas and 25 oratorios - including Messiah with the world-famous chorus "Hallelujah".

Cultural icons and UNESCO Heritage draw visitors to Halle, Handel's hometown

Seven cultural icons are the trademarks of Halle, the hometown of Handel. They crown the birthplace of George Frideric Handel, making it a cultural stronghold filled with charm, art and design. Halle enjoys a central location in the middle of Germany, close to Leipzig-Halle Airport.

The Old Town has a history stretching back over 1,200 years and includes lovingly restored townhouse,

historic churches, parks, colourful streets packed with taverns and many picturesque spots along the river Saale. The town is home to 240,000 residents, who live in the greenest city in Germany, two thirds of which are municipal parks and green spaces (according to the Germany City Report 2012).

August Hermann Francke, the Lutheran theologian and founder of the "Franckeschen Stiftungen" (Francke Foundations) was inspired by the fundamental ideas of the reformer Martin Luther. 300 years ago, he founded the former orphanage and school based on Luther's reformatory principles, which is still preserved today. The "Kulissenbibliothek" (baroque library) and the baroque "Kunst- und Naturalienkammer" (Art and Natural Curiosities Chamber) are unique attractions and a living educational cosmos until today.

With the 3,600-year-old Nebra Sky Disc, humanity's first concrete representation of the sky, Halle is home to a UNESCO treasure. The Sky Disc is included into the UNESCO's memory of the World. Giebichenstein Castle and Moritzburg Foundation Art Museum represent the oldest and the youngest castles along the river Saale. Handel's town is also home to the Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg with over 500 years of history and tradition, the German Federal Cultural Foundation and the Leopoldina – National Academy of Sciences.

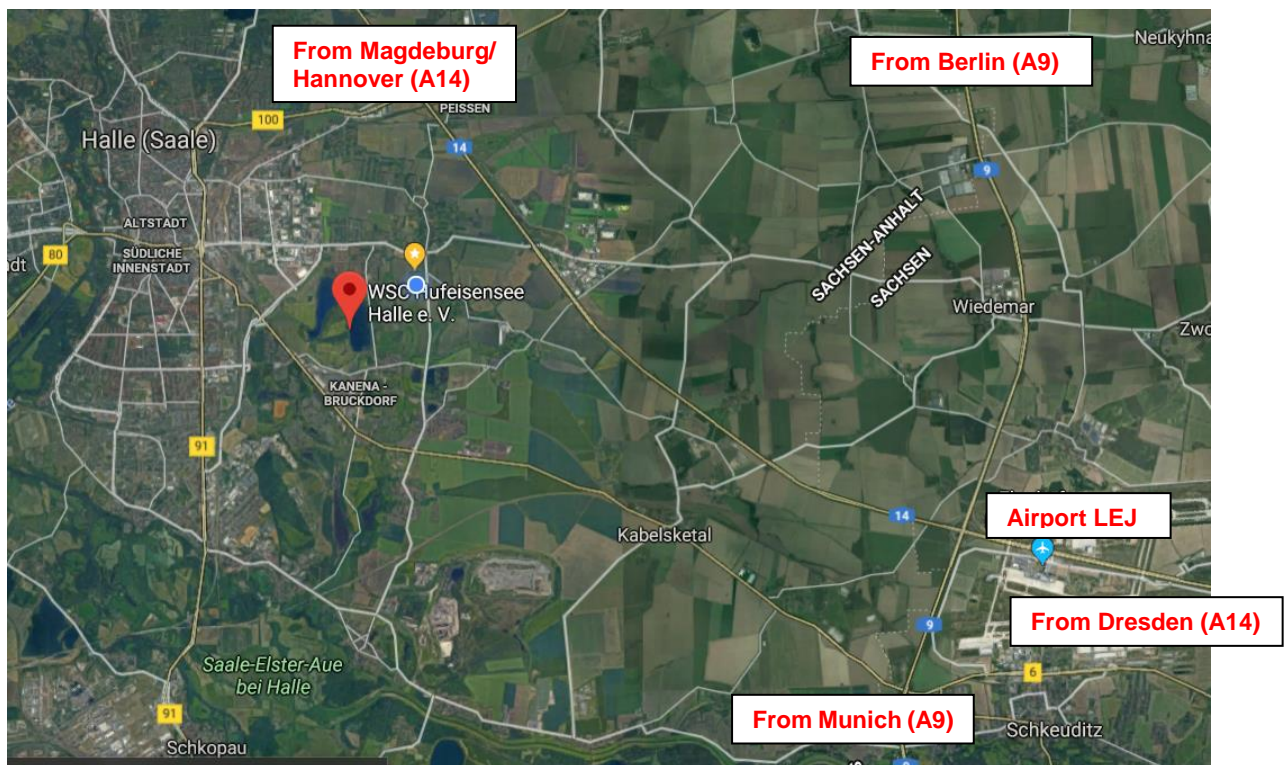

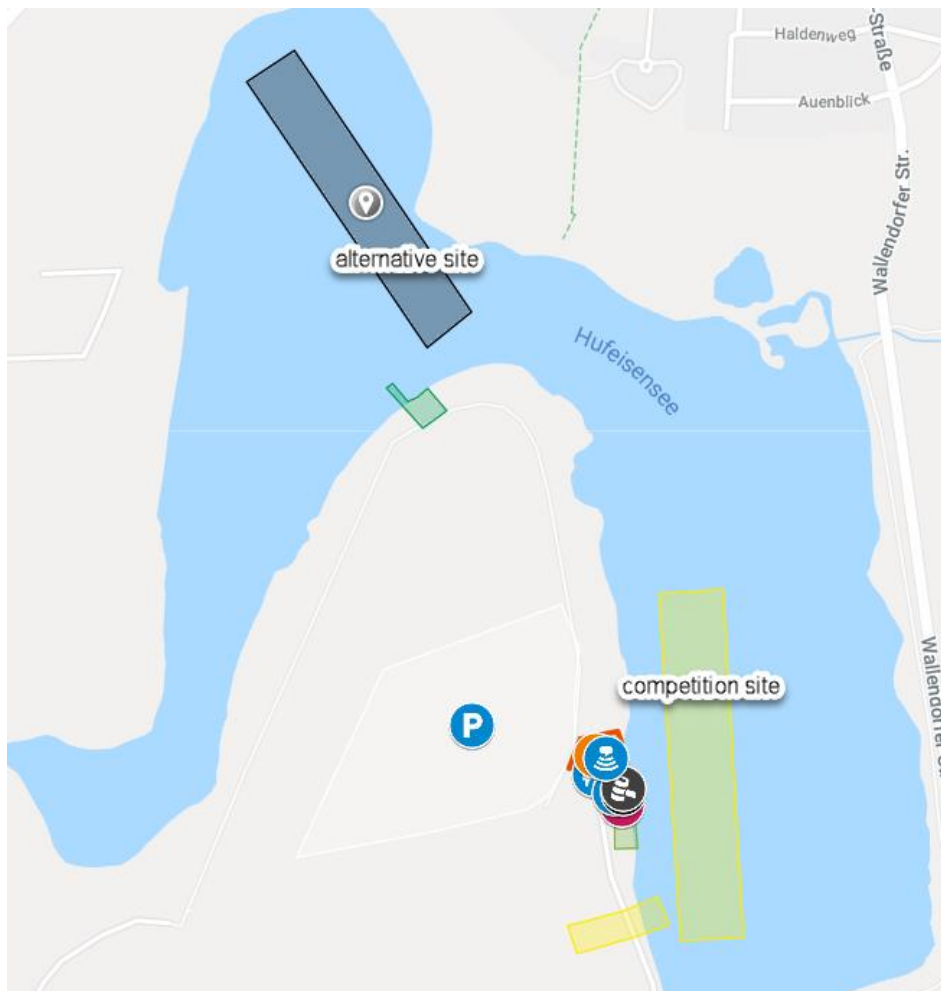

3.13. TRAINING (CHANGED)

Training at Waterski Complex is available from May on forward. Should you be interested to book visit the website or send email to info@seniors-em2018.com for further details. Training times will be offered and sold in 15 minutes intervals (training is total only 12 minutes) on the lake. There will be two sites (competition and alternative site) for training at the Lake Hufeisensee.



Training on site is to be paid in advance to confirm your booking. You can book the training times at the official homepage www.seniors-em2018.com in slots of 15 minutes (training is total only 12 minutes). Set price is 50,00 €. Training should be paid via PayPal plus (fee +6,39%). Once payment is made, please send your proof of payment to info@seniors-em2018.com.

3.14. SITE FAMILIARIZATION (AUGUST 21ST / 22ND) (CHANGED)

(deadline for requests June 24th, using the Intention to Enter form) The last two or three days immediately before the Championships will be reserved and used for Official Familiarization. This will be organized so that each competitor who has paid shall be allocated either a set number of passes and/or a certain amount of time at the discretion of the Chief Judge based on the principle that every skier shall receive an equal opportunity for familiarization.

Slalom skiers will receive – 4 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

Tricks skiers will receive – 2 passes or 5 minutes whichever is less

Jump skier will receive – 3 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

Each team requesting familiarization time shall indicate on the official Intention to Enter form, familiarization is required, which must be submitted at least 60 days before the scheduled start of the event. They must indicate how many skiers in each event wish to participate. Teams who do not comply with this deadline will not be included in the familiarization schedule. At least 45 days before the scheduled start of the event, the Organizer (in consultation with the Chief Judge, whose decision shall be final) shall announce the official familiarization schedule (including the allowed time). Time will be scheduled for competitors on a random team basis, and shall be grouped by event, i.e. slalom familiarisation, trick familiarisation and jump familiarisation (by jump height) will be grouped together.

Any athlete whose time has not been paid for at least 30 days before the scheduled start of the event, or who is not ready to ski in accordance with the schedule, will lose their official familiarization time.

Summary table:

60 days before (June 24, 2018) - deadline for familiarization requests

45 days before (July 9, 2018) - deadline for publishing familiarization schedule by Organizer

30 days before (July 24, 2018) - deadline for familiarization payment

The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarization based on extraordinary circumstances.

The **maximum** cost per hour for Official familiarisation will be € 240,00 (€ 4,00 per minutes).

Your stay may not exceed 90 days.
- If you are coming from any other country, in accordance with EU regulations, you must apply for a visa at the German Consulate for your country. You must also show an official passport.
